

Self Declaration

To minimize the administrative effort, official documents proving your eligibility (e.g. certificates) have not to be provided until signing the employment contract.

This is replaced by the self-declaration, in which you need to explain:

- your status (e.g., experienced researcher)
- nationality/long term resident status (for the initial outgoing phase in the OUTGOING scheme)
- compliance with the mobility rule
- current employment status
- potential career breaks
- if applicable, time spent for obtaining refugee status.
